CONSIDER THIS...

Churches that are growing in number and ministry are getting away from using the term "member" to describe the people of their congregation. As long as I have been a part of the church (since 1977), I never understood what it meant to be a "member". Voting privileges on things I know little about? Stockholder? Reserved pew program? Bragging rights? Decals? Roster spot? "Pearly Gate" quick pass?

As far back as I can remember, becoming a "member" never had anything to do with responsibilities, ministry, participation, growing our faith, reaching out or being fully committed to Christ's ministry.

Churches that are growing replace "member" with "active participants"; two words that describe what it used to be mean to be a "member". Simply put, churches that grow are ones that fuse "intimacy" and "impact". Growing churches are filled with people committed to building solid relationships with a small group of people where they are cared for, challenged, and encouraged (intimacy). Growing churches are filled with people committed to growing their faith through active participation in Worship, Study of Scripture, sharing finances to the capability, understanding their Spiritual gifts in order to serve others (impact).

Which is more useful to Christ: Member or active participant? Some how this makes a lot of sense to me.
