Sojourners Welcome!

Eighteen years ago when Carole and I first moved to Weatherford, we were divorcees beginning a second marriage. We both had lived most of our lives in the Metroplex and were lifelong Baptists. She knew a half-dozen people here and I knew no one. We moved here mostly to get out of the urban congestion, not realizing what a huge step it was to start a new life in our mid-fifties in a strange place. We were like Tex Ritter's boll-weevil – "just lookin' for a home."

Carole was a retired Dallas school teacher and I was still working as a mental health counselor in Fort Worth. We didn't feel comfortable in the local Baptist churches we visited. So, since I was a graduate of Brite Divinity School at TCU, I suggested that we visit Central Christian. Although we both had been members of larger churches, we liked the worship style, the pastor, and the friendliness of the people. As usual, I drug my feet, she joined the choir, and here we are eighteen years later, at home.

Some of you could tell similar stories of coming to Weatherford as strangers seeking a new life and finding your home here. For others, the journey has not been as long in miles but just as arduous.

Few people live all of their lives in one place or remain in the church of their childhood. At times, most of us in one way or another, find ourselves aliens in a strange land. That's why the church must strive to be a welcoming family where sojourners can find a home – however long their stay or whatever their circumstances may be.

We often hear these words of Jesus read at funerals in relation to death: "In my Father's House are many rooms...I go to prepare a place for you. And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you unto myself; that where I am there you may be also." (John 14:2-3) However, I believe this familiar passage has an even wider meaning – that wherever we may sojourn in life, Jesus goes before us, preparing a place for us in our new surroundings.

When we welcome strangers and help them to find their place among us, we not only help Jesus keep this promise, but also pass on the gift of hospitality that we were so graciously given.

The poet Walter Foss wrote: "Let me live in my house by the side of the road and be a friend to man." We would do well to pray: "Lord, may we be Your house by the side of the road, a friendly haven to all who pass by. Amen."
