Be Prepared

This past Tuesday morning our prayer group was meeting in the sanctuary and a gentleman walked in. He was very polite and apologized for interrupting but he needed help. His approach and request put into motion the struggle I think most of us face whenever someone is turning to us for help. He is laying at the Sheep Gate and I know I need to respond – what do I do?

Looking back at how I responded, I am both somewhat proud and somewhat ashamed. Without going into a lot of detail I can tell you my response was much better than it would have been a number of years ago but it still wasn't what it should have been. I was not prepared as well as I should be. I knew my response should not be "nice", it should be "kind" (progress, yea), but what does that look like right here, right now? I wasn't sure (epic fail).

Many years ago someone asked me "Why do you go to church?" At the time the only answer I could offer was "Because left to my own devices I can sure make a mess of things." Even then, I recognized on some level that being a part of His Church was helping me understand how I am to respond to life when life happens. I recognized that learning is a large part of what it means to be a Christian. How should I respond when ... happens?

The Boy Scout motto "Be prepared" is simple and brilliant. As we become more intentional in growing our faith, we prepare ourselves for those "life happens" moments. Through the giving of ourselves in worship, devoting time to prayer and meditation, studying scripture, and working through all of this together, we learn important lessons that prepare us for those times when life happens.

Connect, learn, respond. Be prepared.
