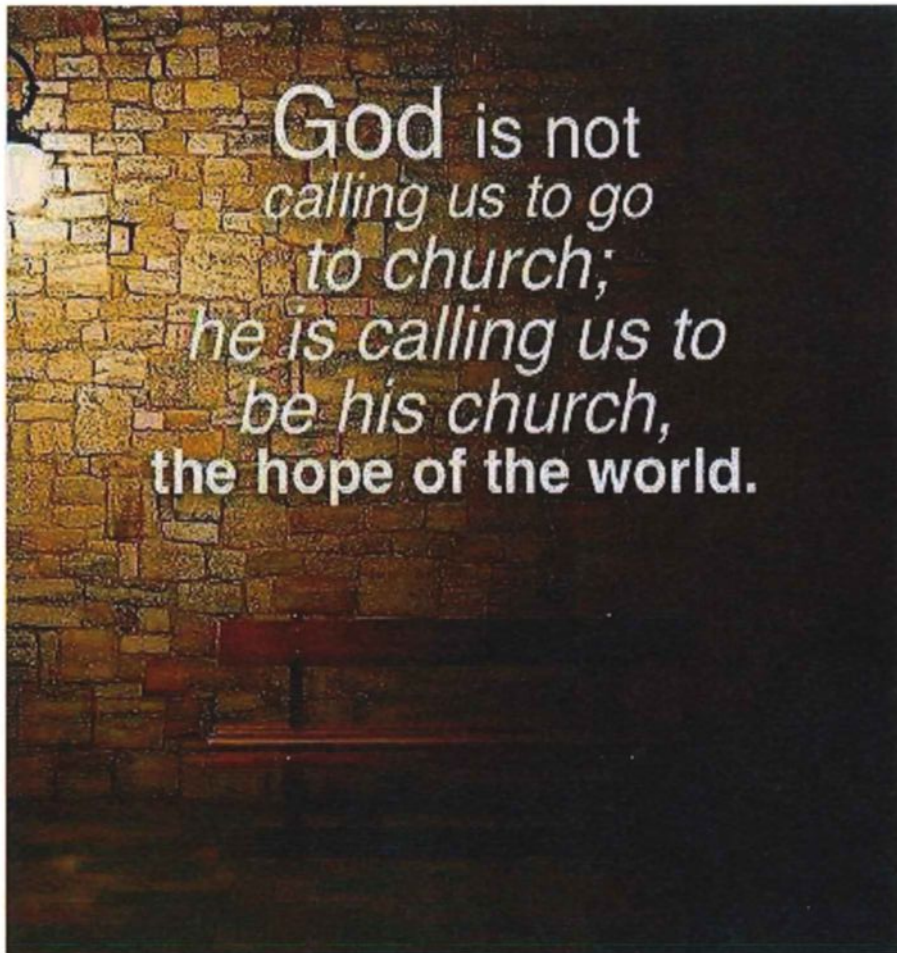

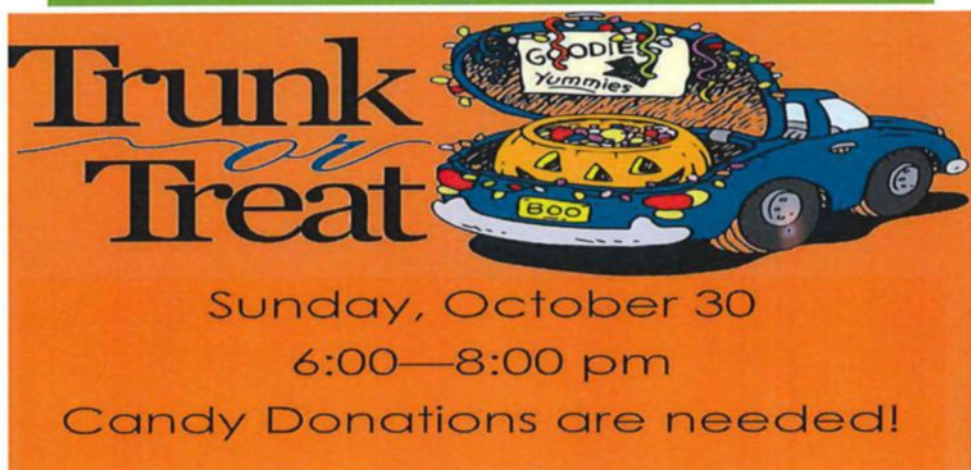

A Prayer For Troubled Times

Most of us, regardless of our political persuasion, are greatly disturbed about the present divisiveness in our nation and the chaos in our world. It's disheartening and almost overwhelming!

In times like these, we often sense a greater need to seek support and guidance from the One who has promised to always love and be with us. Even if we're not much given to prayer, we discover ourselves "standing in the need of prayer."

However, when we're deeply troubled (as I am right now), we may feel that we lack the words and wisdom to voice a coherent prayer to God. In such circumstances, I've learned that it sometimes helps to turn to the prayers of others to give guidance and form to our seeking.

In these most distressing times, I've found help from Reinhold Niebuhr (1891-1971), perhaps the most eminent American theologian of the 20th century, who lived through two world wars, the dust bowl, and the great depression. It was in the midst of his troubled times that Niebuhr penned and prayed this "Prayer for the Nations":

"Look with mercy upon the peoples of the world, so full both of pride and confusion, so sure of their righteousness and so deeply involved in unrighteousness, so confident of their power and so imprisoned by their fears of each other. Have mercy upon our own nation. Purge us of the vainglory which confuses; and give our leaders and our people the wisdom of humility and charity. Help us to recognize our own kinship with whatever savagery or malice confronts us, that we may not add to the world's woe by the fury of our own resentments. Give your Church the grace in this time to be as a saving remnant among the nations, reminding all peoples of the divine majesty under whose judgment they stand, and of the divine mercy of which they and we have a common need. Amen."

As we "wait upon the Lord" and attempt "to walk and not faint" toward election day and beyond, Niebuhr's prayer will keep our feet moving in the right direction – if we take it to heart and pray it often.

Amen and Amen.
