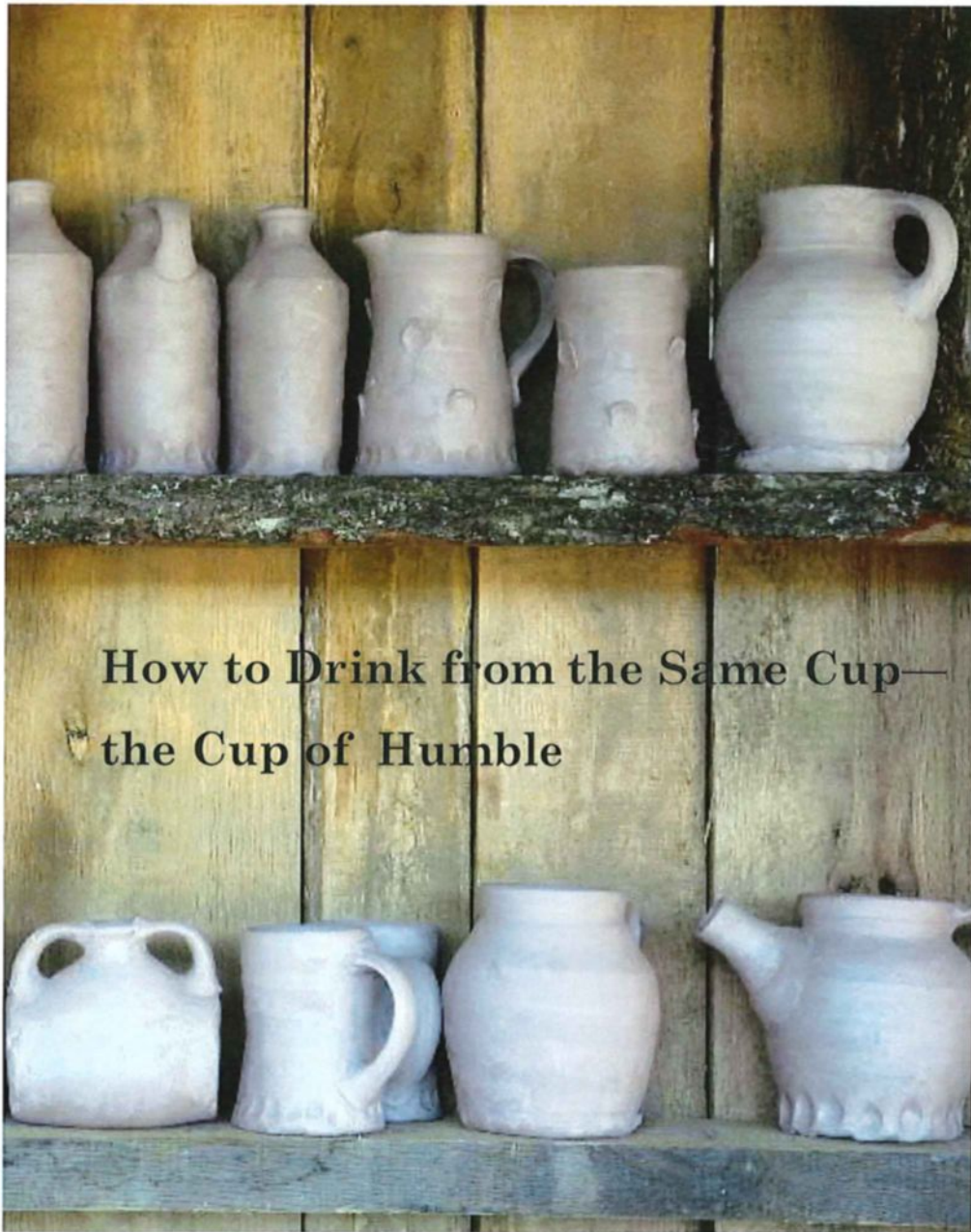

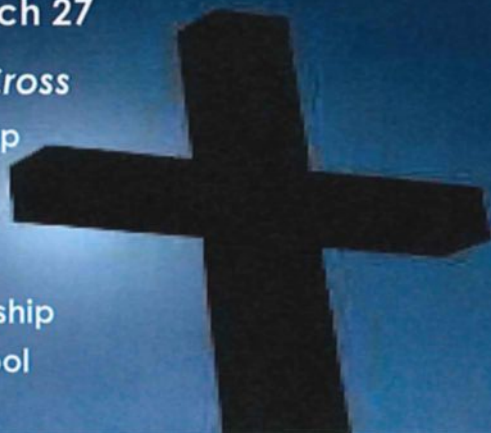

Mind Your B's and Do Nothing's

Whoever says Scripture and religion is not about a list of "do's and don'ts" is wrong. The Scripture used in worship this Sunday reminds us that it IS about "do's and don'ts". Take a look:

**"Be of the same mind,
Having the same love,
Being in full accord and of one mind.
Do nothing from selfish ambition or conceit,
But in humility regard others as better than yourselves.
Let each of you look not to your own interests, but to the
interests of others."**

Well, maybe it's more like "be's and do nothing's". But the Apostle Paul's point is simple: if we are going to follow Jesus then resemble Jesus by having the same mind as Jesus. If we resemble Jesus with our actions, words, gestures, attitude, and behavior then the world will resemble a kingdom where God's reigns – plain and simple.

Plain? Yes, but maybe not as simple as it sounds. The only obstacle in the way of realizing God's vision for our lives is... well...us.

The temptation is to take these lists of "do's and don'ts" and treat them like a laundry list while we go through life as usual. What Paul expressed was when we commit ourselves to learning and growing our faith (Worship, Study, Prayer, and relationships with God's People) then we naturally begin to take on the characteristics that made Jesus who he was. Bottom Line: God's kingdom cannot reign "on earth as it is in heaven" unless it reigns in you first!

How do you know you are moving in the right direction? Test your attitude with the bullet points of "B's and Do Nothing's" above! Then...get back to worship, back to class, back on your knees, back with those who are putting forth the same effort!
