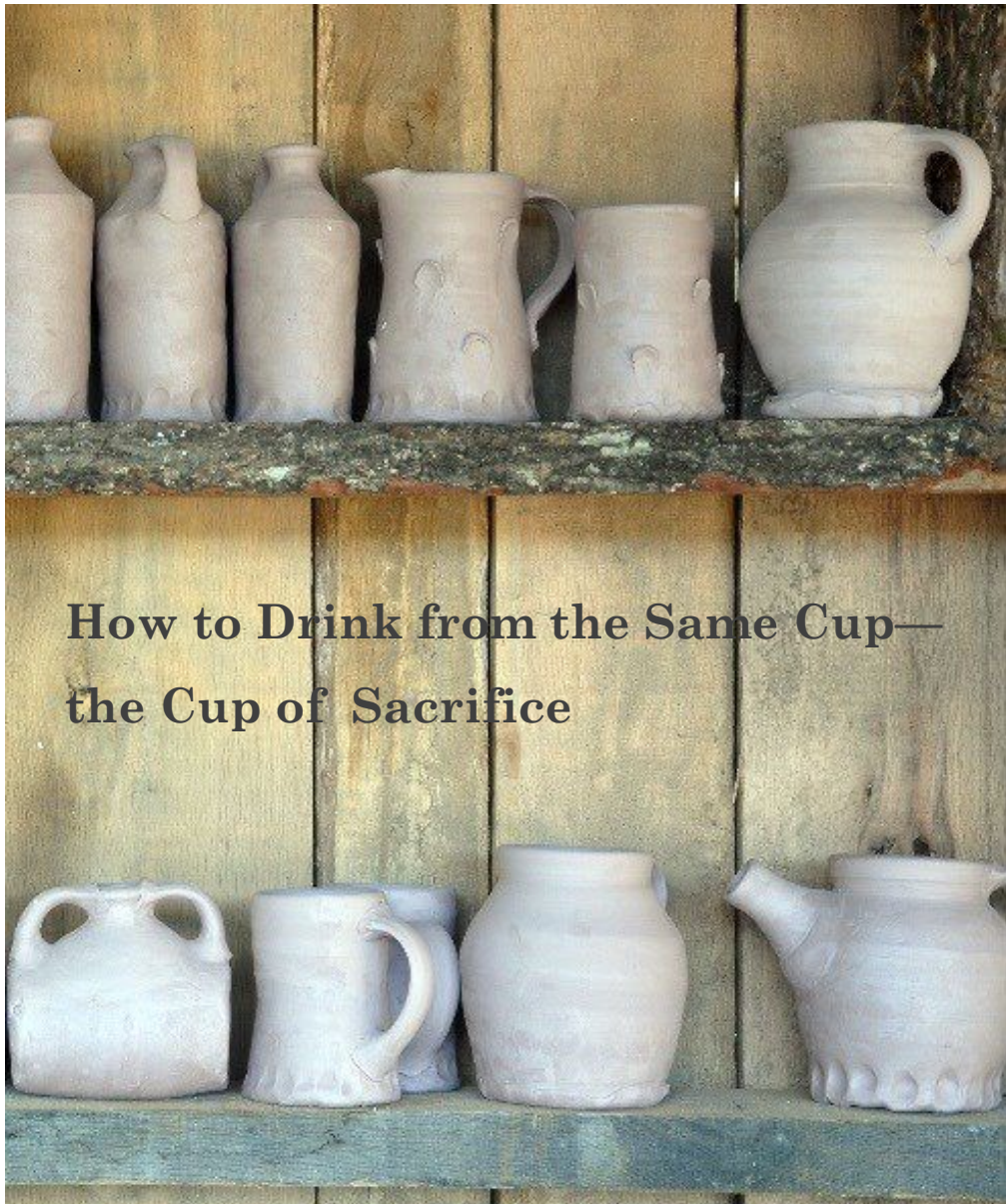

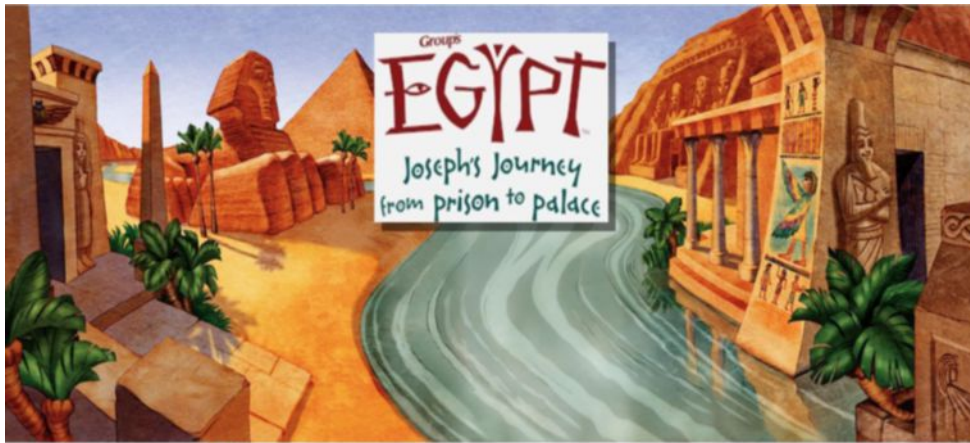

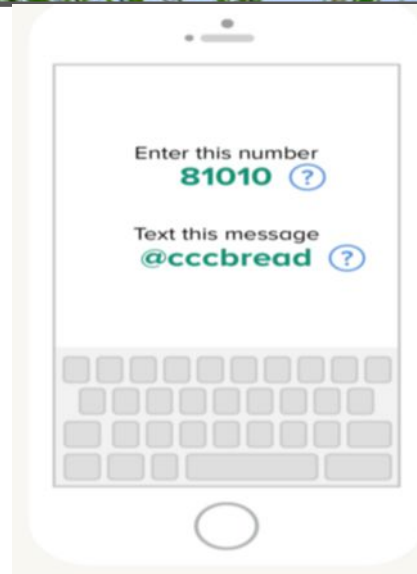

Spoiler Alert by Shannon Moore

You've been looking so forward to sitting down to watch that sports-balling game that you missed. It was the matchup of a life-time: the Celtics vs. the Cowboys. You just couldn't wait to see those players dribbling that football down the court to slam-dunk those touchdowns! But since you had to work, you recorded it. But now you're home; in your recliner; pretzels on the table; diet coke in your hand. And JUST as you're about to hit play on your DVR, your best friend texts:

Can you believe the Cowboys lost in quadruple overtime after Myers made a grand slam?!?!?!?

Your whole life is destroyed! There's no need to watch now. You know what happens. You'll probably never smile again.

Don't you hate it when that happens? These days most publications or online entertainment sources try to warn when they're going to reveal information about a show you may not have watched by using the term "Spoiler Alert." When you see those words, you know not to read any further—lest you ruin the experience of watching your favorite show.

Lent is absolutely one of my favorite times of the Christian year. Helping prepare the choir for their musical offerings is one of the greatest gifts in my life. In addition to working on the more somber songs for Lent and Holy Week, the choir gets to sing the glorious songs celebrating Christ's resurrection. We get a taste of the joy of Easter throughout the Lenten season.

As Christians, we walk with Jesus toward Jerusalem during Lent. We remember his arrest on Maundy Thursday and his crucifixion on Good Friday. But we also know the rest of the story—that 3 days later, Jesus rose from the dead. Knowing what happens on Easter before Easter arrives does not spoil it in the least! During these final two weeks of Lent, I hope you will make plans to visit our prayer chapel on Wednesday afternoons in the parlor; to participate in the Palm Sunday luncheon & egg hunt; to attend the Holy Week services on Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday evenings (March 23-25); and celebrate Easter Sunday morning with — SPOILER ALERT—glorious services of worship!
