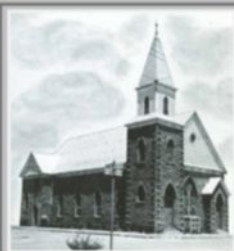

Galileo “seeks and shelters spiritual refugees,” especially young adults, LGBTQ+ people, and the people who love them.
