Rev. Dr. Katie Hays was educated for traditional congregational ministry at Yale Divinity School and Princeton Theological Seminary. She served the traditional church for almost two decades before heading for the spiritual-but-not-religious frontier to plant Galileo Church in the suburbs of Fort Worth in 2013. Galileo "seeks and shelters spiritual refugees," especially young adults, LGBTQ+ people, and the people who love them. It is a vibrant community-of-belonging in Jesus' name where spiritual refugees find a home.

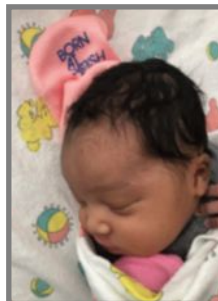
