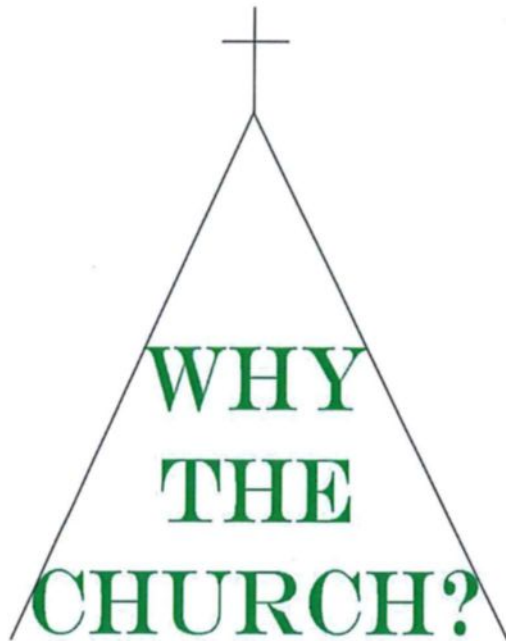

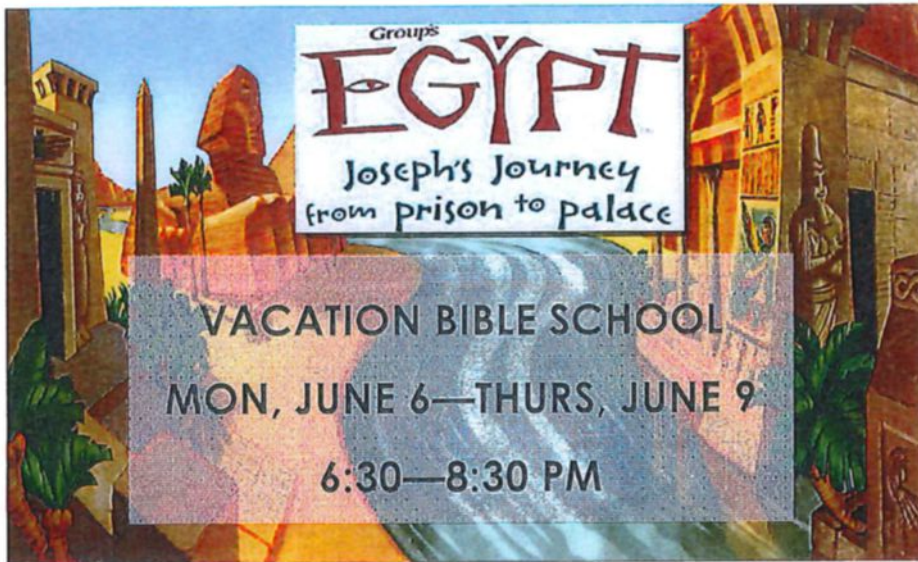

Rob and Sammy

Rob Bell, of NOOMA videos fame, spoke at a Youth Ministry conference I attended a few months ago. He gave a wonderful talk about the nature of mystery and the role of ministry in interactions with people and Divine Mystery. He concluded his talk by telling a story about his experience meeting Sammy Hagar, The Red Rocker, on the set of Good Morning America. After a photo opportunity Rob and Sammy found themselves alone for a moment. Sammy looked at Rob and asked, "So, what do you do?"

Rob paused for a moment, and said, "I believe we're all in this together and there's good news; that there's an empty tomb. That we're going to be okay. And what I get to do with my work, is I get to go around and create space. I get to create space where people can be human. And they can find out that all the stuff they have jammed down inside there, it's okay. Cause I believe that there's something moving in the dark and the light, in the good and the bad. So, I get to create these spaces where people can be free to be fully human, and they can find out that all that stuff, the darkness, there might actually be something good happening there. So I get to go around and do that, and announce good news."

Sammy paused for a moment, and said, "Man, you could change the world with that stuff."

We, as part of the Body of Christ, have an opportunity to "change the world with that stuff." First, we have to find our own words for answering the question, "Why the church?" We have to find our own words for the ways the church can change the world. Second, we have to go and tell. We have to "announce good news." We have good news to share, don't we? We have to let the world know we have good news, and then we have to tell it. Third, we have to create and maintain a space where all people can come into this community and be fully themselves, be fully human.

I pray that we find our own words and also the courage to go and tell.
