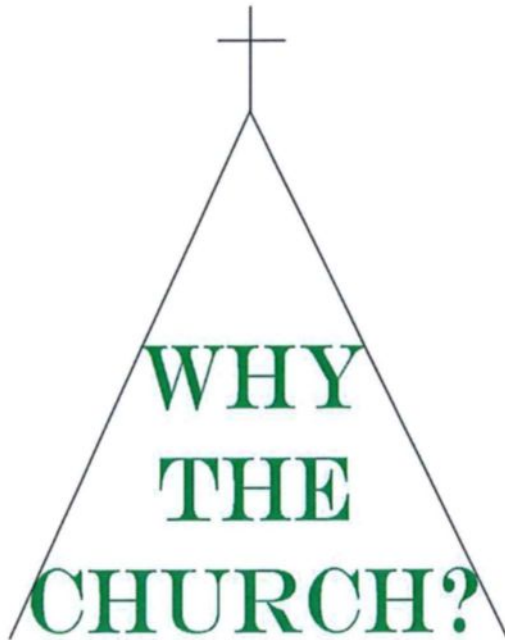

## Scared of Living

I don't know, good people. I get scared of what's happening in this old world. It seems like every day there is another fear: Another shooting. Another bombing. Another explosion. Another attack.

Recently I was at a concert in Fort Worth and as it began, I thought, "What would I do if someone started shooting?" Would I duck? Run? Protect the person next to me? I'll be honest with y'all. I don't like thinking about stuff like that. And I don't like that I have to live in a world and in a time when I feel that I must.

And I get scared. I also get mad—and frustrated—and discouraged—and lots of other emotions. If we are *ALL* God's children, why do we insist on hurting each other in so many ways? It must be that we don't truly believe we are *ALL* God's children. We must think God loves some better than others. And time and again, Cain kills Abel out of his own fears and insecurities and anger.

But being fearful and angry and frustrated is no way to exist. I don't believe that is how God wants us to live. That is not the portrait of the Kingdom of God that Jesus painted.

So what do we do?

First of all, we pray. And I'm not talking about prayer as a last resort. I think we need to pray like it's our job. We need to be asking God to work in our hearts and in the hearts of every person on this planet to recognize that God lives in all of us, and that we are all important. We need to pray for courage and strength and patience and, most importantly, for the ability to love people that we want to hate out of sheer reflex to their actions.

We also need to work on our tolerance for those we don't agree with. And I don't mean only those of different religious or ethnic backgrounds. I mean we have to work on communicating in a civil manner with people close to us who don't have the same political or theological leanings. We need to learn to listen and to be able to disagree with someone without feeling the need to demonize them.

I don't want to be afraid and I will not be afraid. I hope that God will heal us and guide us to be the incredible beings we are designed to be. But it won't happen without a whole lot of work within and without. I believe we can make the world better—but only with God's help.
