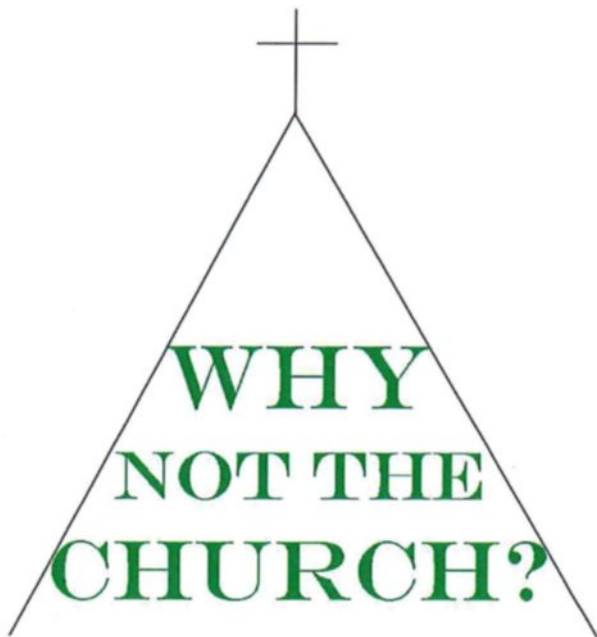

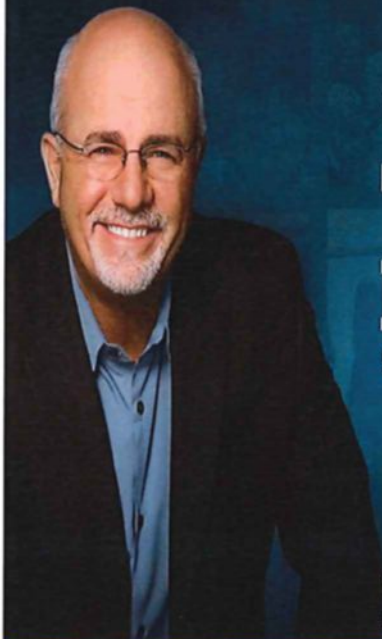

## A Good Place To Start

Sometimes, I think we make building a community, like the church, more difficult than it should be.

Memory may be over-rated in this process. My own memory is not always as good as I remember it being. I often wonder, as Gabby Hayes used to say, if "my saddle is commencin' to slip." That's especially true at church, when it comes to instantly putting names with faces – even familiar ones. Once while teaching Sunday School, my words raced so far ahead of my mind that I resorted to calling Carole, "Wifey."

In church, we sometimes put ourselves under so much pressure to remember names that we withdraw from each other in order to avoid embarrassment. Ironically, at the same time, the other person may be frantically searching their memory for our name. And so, sadly, we pass like ships in the night, failing to make the connection that we both want and need.

Another way we unintentionally distance ourselves from others is by mistakenly believing that we are supposed to know everyone – and know them well. Actually, talking to each other, even about things that don't seem to matter, is the beginning of trust and perhaps even some level of friendship. After all, how many close friends can one person have? There's a whole range of possibilities between casual acquaintances and deep friendships – all important.

"Community, I'm beginning to understand," writes Wendell Berry, "is made through a skill I have never learned or valued: the ability to pass time with people you do not and will not know well, talking about nothing in particular, with no end in mind, just to build trust, just to be sure of each other, just to be neighborly. A community is not something you have, like a camcorder or a breakfast nook. No, it is something you do. And you have to do it all the time."

This view is echoed by Killian Noe: "Sometimes we are astonished when we learn that although we did not actually 'do' anything for a certain individual, our simply being present or showing up allowed something to shift in his or her landscape that made for deeper healing."

So when you come to church, relax. Community and knowing each other is a mysterious process. Showing up and being neighborly is a good place to start. Where it might go from there, God only knows!
